In commemorating the 50th anniversary of the BVI Football Association, we celebrate the remarkable contributions of Mr. Leslie MacMaster. Serving as President from 1979 to 1981, Secretary from 1982 to 1984, and Treasurer from 1984 to 1986, Mr. MacMaster's leadership was instrumental in shaping our football community.



Beginning his playing career in 1971 at age 23, Mr. MacMaster's prowess on the field was soon evident. As a central defender, he became a formidable force, eventually representing the first BVI Men's Team in 1985 and concluding his international career in 1987. His dedication to club football saw him play for Sugar City Strikers, later renamed Budweiser Kings, who dominated the national league in the nineties.



A highlight of his career was being part of the BVI team that clinched the OECS Leeward Islands Football Championship in 1986. Mr. Leslie MacMaster's legacy is a testament to his passion and commitment to BVI football.
